



## WARRANTY

*Stoneworks of Colorado is one of the largest natural stone fabricators in Northern Colorado and prides ourselves on providing and installing material that is in accordance with industry standards created by The Marble Institute of America.*

Natural stone has variances such as discolored spots, veining, pitting and well as epoxy fill.

This warranty covers any defects in the countertops that do not comply with industry standards. As a courtesy, Stoneworks of Colorado will return to repair any scratches, chips or cracks one time during the first year (as long as the jobsite is within 75 miles of Stoneworks of Colorado location).

This warranty does not cover countertops that are broken or damaged after initial installation nor any natural variances as stated above. Stoneworks of Colorado is willing to fix the damages at a discounted rate.

- Any cracks that may occur in a slab after installation that did not occur naturally can generally be repaired as well as the surface polished so it is smooth to the touch. If a certain issue cannot be repaired, please discuss with Stoneworks the alternatives.
- Honed products, marble, travertine and soapstone are more susceptible to staining and scratching. This is the nature of these stones therefore Stoneworks is not responsible for the surface after installation.

### **Sealing recommendations**

- Stoneworks of Colorado is not responsible for any staining that may occur after installation. It is recommended to seal granite countertops once every 8-12 months, marble/travertine/limestone/soapstone every 4-6 months. Lighter granite may need to be sealed 2 to 3 times the first couple of months.

Please ask for recommended sealing methods.
